Introduction

The SC-8100 is a compact note counter, light to carry and easy to operate. The easy access to the note path and sensor area makes it simple to clean the area and to remove jammed notes.

Notes to be counted are placed on the hopper on top of the machine. As the notes are fed into the machine they are counted and then collected onto the stacker pocket at the bottom front.



Updates are done by inserting an SD card in the SD card slot at the back of the SC-8100. Machine upgrades, for example adding another currency, is done by a technician through the USB connection and a PC software. Five different currencies can be installed simultaneously.

The sensors module include:

- IR Infrared Sensor
- MG Magnetic Sensor
- UV Ultra Violet Sensor



Place the machine in a clean environment and on a stable place.


The socket-outlet shall be installed near the equipment and shall be easily accessible.

If the plug on the supply lead to the machine has a fuse, make sure it has the correct rating in amps.



Modes of Operation

Counting Modes

• Mixed counting

Counts a bundle of mixed genuine banknotes of the selected currency.

• Single counting (DD)

Counts only the first denomination detected, all others are rejected.

• Free counting

Counts a number of documents using the sensors activated in the **SET** and **MODE** function.

Note!

The first banknote in a bundle is always the reference note.

Operation

Caution!

Do not press the buttons with sharp objects.

Getting Started

- a) Connect the mains power cord to the mains socket at the rear of the machine. See, "Rear view" on page 4.
- **b)** Start the machine by setting the main switch to on (I).

Note!

Images are only examples and can be different depending on the setup.


Switching Off

- a) Confirm that all counting results are saved.
- **b)** Switch off the machine by setting the main switch to off (0).


Inserting Banknotes

Avoid counting wet, dirty or spoiled banknotes.

- a) Check for foreign matter mixed with the banknotes for example paper chips, rubber bands, clips and dust.
- **b)** Straighten the folds or corners of the banknotes before insertion.
- c) Put the banknotes on the hopper as shown below.



d) Adjust the note guides according to the longest banknote in the stack.



Functions

By default counting starts when the banknotes are placed on the hopper.

• To change the setup to start counting by pressing **START** see "Auto Start On/Off" on page 10.

Note!

Make changes only when there is no banknote on the hopper and in the stacker. However, the functions **DISP** and **PRNT** can be used when banknotes are in the machine.

LCD Screen

The Main view of the screen displays the value and number of counted banknotes.

The List view displays the information as a list with information on value, quantity and number of counted banknotes.

• Press **DISP** to toggle between the two views.

Print a Receipt

- a) Connect a thermal printer to the printer port. See "Rear view" on page 4.
- **b)** Press **PRNT**.

The receipt is printed.

Counting

 a) Press CUR to select a currency or deactivate the detection (OFF) -Detection Off mode.

Note!

The function of **CUR** is only available in the Main view.

b) Press **MODE** to select a sorting mode.

The sorting modes available depends on the settings done in the Advanced Setting see <u>"Sort Mode"</u> on page 14.

c) Start counting.



- a) Press SET.

Activate Auto Start to start counting when the banknotes are placed on the hopper.

- a) Press SET.
- **b)** Press **6** to turn on or off Auto Start.
- c) Press **SET** to exit.

Detection Off Mode



When the detection is deactivated the UV, Size and MG detections can be activated if needed. Settings can be done in the Main view or via the SET menu.

In the Main view:

 - Page 2 (P2) of the SET menu is displayed.
- **b)** Press **7**, **8** or **9** to activate UV, Size and MG respectively.



UV detection. The UV strength is defined by the first banknote of the batch.

Size detection

- a) Press SET
- **b**) Press **8** several times to toggle between the different levels of Size detection.

There are level **S1** to level **S7** to select between. Level **S7** is the most strict size detection level. Default setting is **S3**.



MG detection

Press 9/PRNT to activate the magnetic detection.



Double detection

Press MODE to toggle between the different levels D1 to D5.

Default setting is D2.

Level D5 is the strictest.



Batch Counting

Count a preset number of banknotes from 1 to 999.

In the counting screen:

a) Press **0-9** to enter the desired quantity.

The preset batch is displayed in the upper right corner of the screen.

b) Start counting.

To clear the batch:

- a) Press START.
- **b)** Press **0**.
- c) Press **START** to confirm.





Adjustments

In the Settings menu different adjustments can be done.

- a) Press SET.
- **b)** Press **4** to enter the Settings menu.
- c) To navigate in the menus use

Contrast

Adjust the contrast of the LCD screen from level 1 (light) to level 7 (dark).

- a) Highlight the Contrast icon.
- **b)** Press **PRNT**.
- c) Adjust the contrast up or down with **DISP** or **MODE**.
- **d)** Press **PRNT** to confirm and return to the Settings menu.
 - Press **C** to revert to the previous setting and return to the Settings menu.
- e) Press C to return to the Main view.



Sounds

Alarm

Alarm gives a warning when a suspicious banknote is detected.

- a) Highlight Alarm.
- **b)** Press **PRNT**.
- c) Use up (DISP) or down (MODE) in the list and make a selection.


Alarm Off - warning is turned off. **Suspicious** - alarm is turned on and gives a warning when there is a suspicious banknotes.








Exchange Table

It is possible to set an exchange rate in a local currency for a foreign currency. The result is only shown on the printed receipt (see "Print a Receipt" on page 9).


- a) Highlight the Exchange Table icon.
- **b)** Press **PRNT**.
- c) Press **MODE** to highlight the currency for which a currency will be set.
- **d)** Press **0-9** to insert the current rate (up to six digits).

Press **PRNT** for the decimal separator.

Press **DISP** to delete the last digit.

- e) Press START to return to the Settings menu.
- f) Press C to return to the Main view.

Banknotes are counted with the face of the first detected genuine banknote. Counting stops when a different face or suspicious banknote is detected.

Ornt

Banknotes are counted with the orientation of the first detected genuine banknote. Counting stops when a different orientation or suspicious banknote is detected.

Emisn

Banknotes are counted with the emission of the first detected genuine banknote. Counting stops when a different emission or suspicious banknote i detected.

e) Press PRNT to confirm.





Batch Add Mode

When Batch Add Mode is activated the current sum of banknotes are added to the total counting.

- a) Highlight Batch Add Mode.
- **b)** Press **PRNT**.
- c) Set Batch Add Mode on or off with DISP or MODE.
- d) Press PRNT to confirm.Press C to revert to the previous setting.
- e) Press **C** to return to the Settings menu.





Device Information

To retrieve the currency version and machine detail information.

- a) Highlight the **Device Information** icon.
- b) Press PRNT.

The first page displays the currency version.

c) Press **DISP** or **MODE** to go to the second page which displays machine detail information:

TN: machine type name







Thickness Setting

Thickness setting must always be adjusted to achieve a proper and smooth feeding of banknotes/documents. The thickness is adjusted with the thickness adjustment knob found on the top of the machine, see <u>"Rearview"</u> on page 4.

- If the machine stops frequently and displays **Error-Double Sheet**: Turn the adjustment knob slightly counter-clockwise to decrease the gap between the feed rollers.
- If the banknotes run too hard or too slow:
 Turn the adjustment knob clockwise to increase the gap between the feed rollers.



Troubleshooting

If a fault remains or reoccurs, contact your SUZOHAPP representative.

Error Message	Description/Action	
Error-Dimension	Odd sized banknote/document detected. Check and remove the banknote.	
Error-Denomination	Wrong denomination detected in DD mode.	
Error-Double Sheet	Double fed banknotes/documents detected. Check and recount all banknotes/documents. Adjust the thickness, see <u>"Thickness Setting"</u> on page 15.	
Error Emission	Wrong emission detected in emission sorting mode.	
Error-Paper Jam	A banknote/document is stuck inside the machine. Open up and clear the jammed banknote/document. Make sure no pieces remain	
Error Image	Image of banknote not found in database. Can be caused by dirty or damaged bank- notes.	
Error Ornt	Incorrect orientation detected in orientation sorting mode.	
Error-SlantNote	Skew fed banknote/document. If the problem reoccurs - check thickness adjustment and/or check for dirt in the machine. See "Thickness Setting" on page 15 and "Cleaning" on page 17.	
Error-Timeout	Speed too high when connected to PC Suite. Reduce speed to Medium .	
Error Wrong Face	Incorrect face detected in face sorting. Remove the banknote.	
Unknown document	Unknown document detected in the stacker. Remove the document.	

Reject Reason Message	Description/Action
Batch not completed	Final batch in bundle did not reach the set batch size.
Chain Error	Chain fed banknotes/documents detected. Check banknotes/documents and recount all banknotes/documents.
Check Bill Path	Problems detected in bill path. Open up the bill path and check all sensors for dirt and pieces of paper. Clean the sensors. See "Cleaning" on page 17.
Check Stacker	Check and remove all banknotes/documents from the stacker.
Check Hopper	Check and remove all banknotes/documents from the hopper.
Remove stacker notes	Banknotes/documents detected in stacker. Remove all banknotes/documents.
Stacker Full	The number of banknotes/documents in the stacker have reached the maximum set quantity. Change and set correct batch size.
SuspiciousNote-IR	Banknote with IR image not found, suspect banknote.
SuspiciousNote-MG	Banknote with MG image not found, suspect banknote.
SuspiciousNote-UV	Banknote with UV image not found, suspect banknote.
Wrong Ornt	Detected a banknote with the wrong orientation. Remove the banknote.

Maintenance

Cleaning

Clean the machine daily to prevent from accumulation of dirt, since this may cause too many banknotes to be rejected.

Use an air brush to blow away dirt from the sensors.

Caution!

Only use cleaning materials and tools which do not scratch.

- a) Clean the outside of the machine with a soft cotton towel.
- **b)** Open up the bill path with a firm drag with one hand.
- c) Clean the bill path with a brush or a soft cotton towel.





SD Update

- a) Press SET.
- **b)** Press **4** to enter the Settings menu.
- c) Highlight Device Information.
- d) Press PRNT.
- e) Insert the SD card in the SD card slot. See "Rear view" on page 4.
- f) Press PRNT.
 - The upgrade starts.
 - Wait approximately 3 minutes.
 - Do not operate or turn off the machine.
 - When the upgrade is finished the screen will display **OK**.
- **g)** Reset the machine by switching it off and then on again.


